# PARISH PLANNED GIVING

Since March 2020, largely due to COVID 19, the number of contributors in the Parish Planned Giving and the amount of Parish Collections have dropped significantly.

We sincerely thank all contributors who have maintained their donations.

We are appealing to all parishioners: please consider joining the Parish Planned Giving.

**WHILST THE COSTS OF "OPENING THE DOORS OF THE CHURCH" – PROVIDING THE INFRASTRUCTURE & SERVICES OF THE PARISH THAT WE PERHAPS TAKE FOR GRANTED HAVE NOT REDUCED, THE COLLECTIONS FELL IN THE FOLLOWING NUMBERS:**

- for the financial year to 30 June 2020, planned giving collections fell **\$6,688** or 5.2%. Up to 31 May this year, it has fallen by **\$15,157** or 12.5%.
- for the financial year to 30 June 2020, loose collection fell by **\$8,134** or 28.3%, while for the 11 months this financial year to 31 May, loose collection fell **\$5,668** or 27.5%.
- **active contributors as at 31 May 2021 fell to 172, from 211 in July last year.**

Contributions can be made using weekly envelopes or can be made monthly, quarterly, half-yearly or annually, using specially-numbered envelopes, or via Credit Card.

Contributors may claim a tax deduction of 30% of your donations in respect of the financial year ending 30 June 2021 and in the new financial year ending 30 June 2022. (If you are an existing contributor and you no longer intend to claim the deduction in the new financial year, please inform Parish Office as soon as possible.)

Next year's ENVELOPES will be available from the Planned Giving Table near Our Lady of Grace on the last weekend of June. Please discard any unused envelopes in your current set, as some numbers have been re-allocated.

All contributions for this financial year must be received by Sunday, 27 June 2021.
