“6 WEEKS OF LENT – GIVE 6 THINGS.” Right now, Jesuit Refugee Service is feeding 1000 people a week and the demand for help keeps growing. COVID-19 has disproportionately affected the lives of people seeking asylum and temporary migrants in Australia, as they remain excluded from all forms of Federal government support. This has meant that people who were once working and self-sufficient have had to rely on charities, like JRS, for rent, medication, bills and food.

To help keep everyone fed, we are asking parishioners to donate one item a week:

- Week 1: Basmati Rice (1kg or 2kg bags)
- Week 2: Tuna in oil
- Week 3: Cooking oil (750ml/1L or 2L bottles)
- Week 4: Tinned Tomatoes
- Week 5: Tinned Lentils/Chickpeas/Red Kidney Beans
- Week 6: Pasta (spaghetti, penne, spiral, etc... please not tinned spaghetti)

At the end donations can be dropped at the JRS office at 10-12 Victoria Rd, Parramatta between 12 - 15 April or 3 - 6 May. To drop off items, please email: foodbank@jrs.org.au or call 9098 9336. Please be sure to book a date/time in advance as we have limited parking and storage space at our new office.
